Lewis the Stove which may be in use in the Kitchen at the Death of me, and my wife Urabella Lewis.

(II) I give, and bequeath to my wife Urabella Lewis all the Personal Property belonging to me at my Death, except one Bedstead and Bed, and Bedding belonging to the same marked with the letter M. L. to my son Maxon Lewis, and one Bedstead, and Bed, and Bedding marked H. H. L. to my son Henry Lewis, to be delivered to them as it suits the convenience of my wife Urabella Lewis, and it is my wish to have what should remain of the Personal Property given to my wife at her Death, to be equally divided amongst my four Daughters Oswego March 6th one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven.
