BE IT REMEMBERED, That heretofore, to wit, on the 9th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four Margaret M. Burt Executrix named in the LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF Mary Burt late of the city of Oswego in the County of Oswego deceased, appeared in open Court, before the Surrogate of the County of Oswego and made application to have the said LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT which relates to both Real and Personal Estate proved; and on such application, the said Surrogate did ascertain by satisfactory evidence who were the heirs at law, and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences.

and said surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation in due form of law, directed to the heirs at law, and next of kin by their respective names, stating their respective places of residence requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at Court House in the city of Oswego in the said County, on the 5th day of June A. D. 1874 to attend the Probate of said Will.

And afterwards to wit: on the 5th day of June A. D. 1874 satisfactory evidence by affidavit, was produced and presented to said Surrogate, of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law; and on that day no one appearing to oppose the Probate of such Will such proceedings were thereupon had in said Court afterwards, that the said Surrogate took the proofs of said Will hereinafter set forth, upon this 5th day of June A. D. 1874 and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the proofs thereof to be sufficient, which said LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT and proofs are as follows, that is to say:
