 life do make and publish the my last will and testament in manner and
 form following, that is to say: First, I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved wife Mary Baker all my real and personal estate which
 I have during the natural life, meaning after my decease the
 property both real and personal shall be equally divided amongst all
 my children, viz; Benjamin Baker, Frank Taylor, Susan
 Baker, Sarah Baker, Susan Baker, Susannah Baker, Mar-
 tinal Baker, Clark Baker, Eunice Baker, Eliza Baker and
 William Baker, meaning that the property shall be equally di-
 vided between them all except those who I have given or
 selling out to, or have given any property to, meaning the amount
 of what I have given: and each one shall be deducted
 from or be considered so much towards their share of this
 property after my wife's decease. Lastly I hereby appoint my
 beloved wife Mary Baker sole executrix of this my last
 will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal at Albion this twenty
 fourth day of September in the year of our Lord and
 Kings and eighth year of Queen Victoria
 signed sealed published and declared by the above
 named Peter Baker to be his last will and testament in
 presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our
 names as witnesses in presence of the testator
