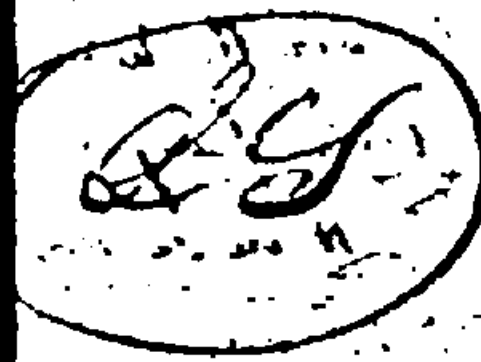

I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that on the day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven personally appeared before me Joseph M. Clark Surrogate of the County of Oswego of the Will of William Stone late of the City of St. Louis in the Province of New Brunswick deceased and who lastly died at Oswego in the said County of Oswego. And the said Edwin M. Clarke being duly sworn declared that he did see the said William Stone deceased seal & execute the said Instrument hereunto annexed and impaled with the Seal of Office of the said Surrogate which said Instrument purports to be the last Will and Testament of the said William Stone deceased bearing date the thirtieth day of August in the year aforesaid that he heard from the said William Stone publish and declare the same as and for his last Will & Testament that at the time thereof he the said William Stone was of sound disposing mind and memory to the best knowledge & belief of him the said Edwin M. Clarke and that he together with William Goddard and Edmund S. Howa the other Witnesses to the said Will did severally subscribe their names thereto as Witnesses in the presence of the Testator - and on the day of September aforesaid also personally appeared William Goddard another of the subscribing Witnesses to the said Will of the said deceased who being also duly sworn declared that he did see the said William Stone deceased seal and execute the instrument aforesaid that he heard from the said William Stone publish and declare the same as and for his last Will and Testament that to the best of his knowledge & belief the said William Stone at the time thereof was of sound disposing mind and memory and that he the said William Goddard together with Edmund M. Clarke

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of Edmund S. Howa the other Witnesses to the said Will did in the presence of the Testator severally subscribe their names as Witnesses thereto

This last Will and Testament of Isaac Johnson of the County of Oswego and State of New York - Isaac Johnson considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory do hereby be throughly God for the same - do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say Whereas I am seized of twenty acres of land in the County of Oswego being part of lot number ten in great lot number seven in the tract bounded as follows Beginning at the South West Corner of said lot and running South on the West line of said lot thirty three rods then East in a line parallel with the South line of said lot so far as to contain twenty acres. Now therefore I give and bequeath to my wife Semina and to her heirs and assigns forever all the above described premises with the appurtenances upon the condition however that if my son Isaac H. Johnson shall take good care of and afford a good and sufficient support to my wife Semina and myself from this time forward then and in that case I give and bequeath to my son Isaac H. the use and improvement of all my said lands and if my said son Isaac H. shall continue to afford the support aforesaid in every respect that is a provision clothing widow and medical attendance nursing and every other attendance suitable to people of our age during the lives of myself and my wife Semina and the survivors of us then and in that case I give and bequeath to my said son Isaac H. at the decease of the survivor
