The last will & Testament of Samuel Huguenin of the Town of

I the said Samuel Huguenin considering the uncertainty of
this mortal life & being of sound mind & memory do make
& publish this my last will & Testament in manner & form
following.
First I give bequeath & devise unto my beloved wife Mary
Huguenin all my estate real & personal in possession or
remainder for & during her natural life, provided she
shall so long continue sole & unmarried after my decease
& after her decease or in case she shall again marry
after my decease, then & in either of these events I give

devise bequeath & dispose of my real estate as follows viz
I order & direct that my Executors hereafter to be named
shall sell & dispose either at private sale or public auction
as they or a majority of them shall see fit all that lot sit-
uate in the village of West Oswego Seneca & distinguished
as lot number twenty five being that on which I now
reside, for cash & shall dispose of & divide the proceeds
thereof in the following manner to wit, to Lucretia the wife
of John S. Malbrach they shall pay the sum of eighty
dollars, to my son Abraham S. Huguenin they shall pay
the sum of sixty dollars, to my son Hiram Huguenin they
shall pay the sum of sixty dollars & to my sons Peter S.
Huguenin & Daniel Huguenin Jr. each the sum of ten dol-
lars & the remainder of the sum for which the aforesaid
lot with the appurtenances may sell, I will & direct shall
be divided by my Executors between my daughters Mary
Betsey Nancy & Catherine or their heirs, share & share alike
I do give, devise & bequeath unto my sons Robert & Leonard
& to be divided equally between them, all that portion of
Water lot number eight in the village of West Oswego
which lies between the lot of Henry Cagle on the north & the
lot of my son Hiram Huguenin on the south, to be bound-
ed on the west by the West line of the aforesaid lot of
Hiram Huguenin, as described in the deed given by me to
the said Hiram.
I do order & direct that the remainder of my real estate
wheresoever situate, shall be sold by my Executors either at private
sale or public auction as they or a majority of them shall
see fit & shall divide the proceeds thereof between my daugh-
ters Mary, Betsey, Nancy, & Catherine & my sons Robert &
Leonard, share & share alike
I give & bequeath unto my wife Mary, all my personal
estate, to be disposed of as she may think best.
