

I have any estate, or to which I have any title. Together with the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto, belonging or in any wise appertaining to that part of the said premises, uncovered as herebefore expressed.

And you and in consideration as aforesaid I have given and bequeath in addition to former bequests, to my said son James all my stock of cattle and horses, and carriages, and all other goods and chattels belonging to me and which I have a legal right to bequeath, consisting of all my personal estate, and also all debts, dues and demands whatsoever to me owing, or by me to be claimed or received.

And I make, constitute and ordain my good friends John Muddall of Grants, in said county of Orange, and my said son James V. Miller of the place last aforesaid to be my executors on my said personal estate for my said wife Polly and my said son James, and it is my will that they should pay out what monies shall be due I should have at the time of my decease, but so as not to be accountable for any such debts that shall be contracted, and that they shall retain their reasonable charges and expences in relation to their said trust. And I will see my body after burial, and that no greater sum shall be expended thereupon than shall be deemed necessary by my executors.

In witness whereof I the said Cornelius Miller have to this my last will and testament set my hands and seal the twenty third day of August, in the year of our said Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.

Hooover the subscribing witness to the will of Cornelius Miller late of the County of Orange in said County of Orange, who being duly sworn declared that he did see the said Cornelius Miller deceased seal and execute the instrument hereunto annexed and imprefixed with the seal of the office of the said Surrogate which said instrument purports to be the last will and testament of the said Cornelius Miller deceased bearing date the twenty third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one that he heard from the said Cornelius Miller publish and declare the same as and for his last will and testament that at the time thereof he the said Cornelius Miller was of sound disposing mind and memory to the best knowledge and belief of him the said Charles H. Hoover, and that he together with his brother Mondrian Henry the other witnesses to the said will did severally subscribe their names thereto as witnesses in the presence of the testator.
