And lastly as to all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate goods and chattels of what kind and nature soever (except my household furniture which I bequeath to my beloved wife and from her to my five daughters) I give and bequeath the same to my youngest son Cyrus French whom I hereby appoint sole executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills thereto made.
