 schooling each and when of age each a three year old
 heifer and be supported by Jacob Quackenbush and
 schooling and heifers given by him. all the real
 and personal property of my estate goods and chattels
 and debts due and demands to be paid on the land
 debt I give and bequeath to my dear beloved wife
 Betty Quackenbush whom I nominate con-
 stitute and appoint sole executrix of this my last
 Will and Testament as long as she remains my kind
 lawful making all other and former Wills by
 at any time heretofore made. In Witness whereof
