Orange County - It is remembered that on the sixth day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty before me Joseph W. Nelson Surrogate of the County of Orange aforesaid personally appeared Theodore F. Remyer & James George of the Town of Polny in said County subscribing witnesses to the foregoing will of Rufell Brockway late of the Town of Polny aforesaid who being solemnly sworn did and each for himself did declare that they did see the said Rufell Brockway duly read and execute the same it having been first read to and in the hearing of the said Rufell Brockway that they heard him the said Rufell Brockway publish and declare the same as if for his last will and testament that at the time thereof he the said Rufell Brockway was of sound disposing mind & memory to the best knowledge and belief of them the said Theodore F. Remyer & James George and that they in the presence of the testator & of each other at the time did solemnly subscribe their names thereto as witnesses. The Testimony a hereof the said Surrogate hath sworn at his office and affixed his seal of Office Done at Richland in said County the sixth day of March one thousand eight hundred & thirty
