I also give and bequeath to my daughter Lurial, my white backed
cow, I also give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Coe one red year
ling heifer - to my three two sons, William Coe and Abram Coe, each
their support and maintenance, out of my estate until they are twenty
one years of age, provided they continue till that time, to live and labor
in my farm, herby devised to my said son Jerome, I further give, and
bequeath, out of my said estate two hundred dollars, to each of my two
sons, William and Abram, to be paid to them by my said son Jerome
when the said William and Abram shall be actually arrived at the age
of twenty one years - and lastly, I further give and bequeath to my said
eldest son Jerome, my span of horses which I now use as a team, one gray
colt one weigone, my harness, sleigh, and all other unenumerated, out of
of personal property except sufficient to pay all my debts, which my said
son Jerome is to pay, out of the goods, and chattels herby given, and be-
queathed to him, and also all my personal estate claims and dem-
ands of what ever kind and nature, and I also herby appoint, my
beloved wife Thelma Coe executrix of what my said son Jerome Coe and I
them the right executors of this, my last will and testament her
writing, all former wills by me made, in and whereof I have herein
set my hand, and seal, the thirtieth day of May in the year of our
