

my death as she shall remain unmarried and from and after her marriage with any other person or husband and in case she should again never intermarry with any other person or husband then from & after her decease I give and bequeath the same to the legal heirs of my body after the payment of my debts funeral expenses & legacies as aforesaid & will & bequeath unto my beloved son George Henry Dewey all the remaining part of my estate both real and personal embracing a house & lot in east Oswego & being a part of lot number forty nine in Block eighty two together with the appurtenances thereto belonging for him the said George Henry to have & to hold to his use & benefit and to his heirs & assigns forever And I hereby give the custody tuition and guardianship of my said son George Henry who is now an infant under the age of twenty one years to my brother Joshua W. Dewey of Barlow in Oswego county and hereby elect & appoint the said Joshua W. Dewey to be the guardian of my said child if he shall be within the age of twenty one years at the time of my death as aforesaid until the said George Henry shall arrive at the full age of twenty one years and during his minority in case the said George Henry or the legal heirs of my body should die before they or he arrives at the age of twenty one years then I will & bequeath all of my estate hereby given to the said George Henry or my said wife Caroline during her widowhood and in case of her decease or in case of her intermarriage with any other person or husband then & from thence I will & bequeath all of my said residuary estate to my nearest blood relatives to be divided among them share & share alike And I hereby order & direct that all of the rents issues & profits of my real estate and also of my personal estate after the liquidation and settlement of my debts ^{as aforesaid} funeral expenses and after one third thereof shall have been paid to my said wife Caroline during her life or widowhood shall be paid to the said Joshua W. Dewey during the minority of my said infant son and to be applied by him for his maintenance and support And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Benjamin S. Morgan and Lucas Van Schaack both of Seneca in the county aforesaid and my brother Joshua W. Dewey of Barlow in Oswego county aforesaid executors of this my will hereby revoking & making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made & declare this my will to be my last will and testament On 14th line on the first page which is in the 17th line of same page and in the 7th line of the third page intention being signed & subscribed at 23rd times on 3 page & on 24th 7.9.10 lines on 4 page On witness whereof the said estate George Henry Dewey gave to this my last will and testament at my hand & seal this thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one

Brand & Sidney Clark of the County of Seneca in the County of Oswego being each duly sworn depose testify & say that they were each well acquainted with Henry Dewey of the place last aforesaid that said Henry did on the 25th Day of June last as they have been informed & believed to be true that each subscribed his name to an instrument bearing date the 25th Day of June last as witnesses thereto which said instrument purport to be the last will & testament of said Henry Dewey deceased That each of us witnesses saw said Henry execute said instrument at the same time declared the same to be his last will & testament that each subscribed his name as a witness thereto at the request of said Henry & that at the time of the execution thereof said Henry was of sound disposing mind & memory & not under any restraint in the opinion of said witnesses
