I hereby give and direct that the Executors hereinafter named pay
all the debts that I may owe at the time of my Decease, and also the
funeral charges, and further order that they collect all the debts due on
my account and by me with my wife Charlotte the one third part of
all the real estate that I shall own together with the buildings and
appurtenances thereunto belonging, being the same premises now occup-
ied by me, and containing about two hundred and six acres of land
part of lot number thirty two, forty two and forty three in the
township of Saratoga, excepting thereout that part of said premises
situate on lot number forty four, and lying on the north west
side of the road leading from Thomas Mills to Oswego, and I further
give and bequeath with my wife two beds and bedding for the same
two bedsteads, the oldest bureau, one round covered table, my new
chair, one large rocking chair, and one sewing chair, one carpet, one
third of the iron ware and brass ware, except the brass hand cross,
one walnut framed looking glass, one cane and one bag, one sewing
stand with one draw, also the use of the chairs ware, so long as
she remains my widow, and when married again or dead to be
given to my son Charles S. and I further give my wife one set of
bed curtains.

I give and devise unto my son Frederick S. the sum of Five Dollars
to be paid out of my personal property, by my Executors in two years
from the time of my Decease

I give and devise unto my son Nathan S. the sum of Five Dollars
to be paid out of my personal property, by my Executors in
two years from the time of my Decease.

I give and devise unto my three youngest sons viz; William S. George
H. and Charles S. the remaining two thirds of all my real estate, situate
aforesaid, to be divided equally between them, all to share and share alike
subject to contribute to the payment of a legacy or bequest to my Da-
ughter Charlotte herein after mentioned, all to pay equal shares of said be-
quest, and I further give to my son Charles S. one sewing stan-
