and to come, to George Cole his brother, now married and fifty dollars
at or before the time said George shall arrive at twenty five
years of age, which said sum I give and bequeath unto said
George to be paid by Benjamin as above mentioned, or if not so
paid said George is to retain that amount of interest in said farm.

I give and bequeath unto Abner Cole & Deborah Whitson Cole a
piece of land lying & being situate in the town of St. Albans
county of Vermont, situate on what is called
the north west corner & being known as part of the Sage farm

I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Whitson the one of Benjamin
Whitson deceased a certain piece of land situate and being on the east
corner as called there, in the town of Glassbury, county
of Huntington, and State of Vermont, land partly as to all the
remainder of my personal estate, goods & chattels, of what kind and
nature soever, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
bliss my wife, whom I appoint sole executrix of this my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the
5th day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty four
