In the Name of God Amen! I George Males of Scriba do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following.

I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping and believing in the remission of my sins by the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ and my body to commit to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named, and my worldly estate I give and devise as follows to wit, to my beloved wife Cynthia Males I give and devise all my real estate Messuages or tenements known as the east half of lot Number forty two in the 17th Township of Scriba's patent called Hamilton's Bone and Twenty five Acres from the south west corner of lot Number forty three same Township, parting and being adjacent. Also all my personal property and effects consisting of all my stock, teams, farming utensils, household furniture, and all and every of my property I do hereby absolutely give and bequeath and give to my said beloved wife Cynthia aforesaid, to have, hold, to hold to her my said wife use and benefit as she may see fit during her natural life. And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife sole executrix of this my last will and testament and authorize her wholly and absolutely to buy, occupy, control, and dispose of all of the said property, as well the real as personal estate as she may deem proper and right.
