1. James Low aged 51 years of the city of Solids Lucas County Ohio being publicly sworn pursuant to the directions hereto annexed, and examined on the part of the executing, doth depose and say.

To the first interrogatory he saith -

1. His age is 51 years, Occupation - His residence Solids Ohio.

To the second interrogatory he saith,

2. He was acquainted with Captain Cyrus Tracy, lived with him a year or more, He died at the boarding house of a Mr. Reed in Solids Ohio.

To the third interrogatory he saith,

3. Has looked at the instrument purporting to be the will of Cyrus Tracy, which is annexed. He (witness) was present when said will was executed, and saw said Cyrus Tracy sign it.

To the fourth interrogatory he saith,

4. He did see said Tracy sign said will.

To the fifth interrogatory he saith,

5. The witness D. S. Saltonstall, Daniel Wadsworth (who also signed as witnesses) Mr. Tracy, and he thinks one or more doctors were present, and all signed the instrument in the presence of said Cyrus Tracy.

To the sixth interrogatory he saith,

6. The said Cyrus Tracy, did declare in the presence of all the witnesses, that the annexed paper signed by him, was his last will and testament, and he requested us to witness it as such.

To the seventh interrogatory he saith,

7. He knows of no other matter or thing which will tend to the proving of said will except what he will state in answer to the next interrogatory.

To the eighth interrogatory he saith,

8. He thinks the said Cyrus Tracy, was of sound mind and memory, when he executed said last will. He was laboring under no restraint, whatever. He considers him as competent to the transaction.

Daniel Wadsworth aged 27 years of the city of Solids Lucas County Ohio being publicly sworn pursuant to the directions hereto annexed and examined on the part of the executing, doth depose and say.

To the first interrogatory he saith,

1. His age is 27 years, his occupation a Book Keeper, his residence Solids.

To the second interrogatory he saith,

2. He was acquainted with Captain Tracy, for 4 or 5 months he lived at the boarding house of Mr. Reed in Solids.

To the third interrogatory he saith,

3. He has examined said paper annexed, was present and saw the said Cyrus Tracy sign it.

To the fourth interrogatory he saith,

4. He did see Captain Cyrus Tracy sign said instrument.

To the fifth interrogatory he saith,

5. Mr. Tracy, D. S. Saltonstall, James Low and perhaps some of the doctors & myself were present, and the said Cyrus Tracy was present when the witnesses all signed said instrument.

To the sixth interrogatory he saith,

6. Said Cyrus Tracy did declare in my presence that said instrument was his last will and testament.

To the seventh interrogatory he saith,

7. Knows of nothing but what he will state in answer to the next interrogatory.

To the eighth interrogatory he saith,

8. Thinks he was of sound mind and memory when he executed said will. Thinks he was under no restraint of any kind - and was as competent to transact business as he ever said a man who was as weak as he was, and further says not.
