 the end thereof the instrument here produced  
 and shown to this deponent, purporting to be  
 the last will and testament of the said  
 deceased bearing date the 13th day of April 1847  
 that the said testator at the same time declared  
 the instrument so subscribed by him to be his

Be it remembered that heretofore to-wit on the

 A.D. 1850 Mary A. Wilson Executrix named & appointed in the  
 last will & testament of Mary A. Wilson late of the city deceased, appeared  
 in open court before Orla H. Whitney County Judge of Oswego County &  
 made application to have said last will and testament which  
 relates to both real and personal estate proved; and on such applica-  
 tion the county judge did ascertain by satisfactory evidence who were  
 the heirs and next of kin of said deceased and their respective residences,  
 and said judge did thereupon issue a citation in due form of law  
 directed to the said heirs and next of kin by their respective names  
 stating their respective residences requiring them to appear in this  
 court at the Oswego Hotel in the city of Oswego, on the sixth day of  
 February then next and attend the probate of said will, and after  
 to-wit on the said sixth day of February satisfactory evidence by  
 affidavit was produced and presented to said judge of the service  
 of the said citation in the mode prescribed by law and on  
 that day no one appearing to oppose the probate of such will such  
 proceedings were thereupon had that the county judge took the proof  
 of the said will hereinafter set forth, upon this sixth day of  
 February A.D. 1850 and he adjudged the said will to be  
 a valid will and the proofs thereof to be sufficient, which  
 said will and proofs are as follows to-wit:

I Mary Ann Wilson of the City and County of Oswego and  
 State of New York widow of James Wilson late of the same place deceased  
 do make and publish this my last will & testament in manner fol-  
 lowing to-wit:

First I constitute and appoint Edwin Skinner of said City of Oswego  
 executor and Mary Ann Wilson my daughter in law of said City  
 of Oswego of this my last will & testament.  
 Second I charge all my estate and effects of every description  
 payment of my debts, and funeral and testamentary
