

Be it remembered, that heretofore to wit on the 27th day of May A.D. 1850 Willard Barnes Legatee named in the last will & testament of Delana M Barnes late of Albion in Oswego county deceased, appeared in open court before the surrogate & county Judge of Oswego county and made application to have the said last will and testament which relates to real and personal estate proved: and on such application the county Judge did ascertain by satisfactory evidence who were the heirs and next of kin of the said testatrix, and their respective residences and some of them appearing to be minors having no general guardian, residing in the state of New York, a special guardian was appointed in due form of law, to take care of their interests in the matter aforesaid the said will by an order entered for that purpose by said surrogate & Judge, and said Judge & surrogate did thereupon issue a citation to the said heirs and next of kin & special guardian by their respective names stating their respective residences requiring them to appear before said Judge at his office in New York on the tenth day of June then next, and attend the probate of said will, and afterwards to wit on the said tenth day of June satisfactory evidence by affidavits was produced and presented to said Judge of the service of the said citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day no one appearing to oppose the probate of such will such proceedings were thereupon had afterwards that the county Judge took the proof of said will hereinafter set forth upon this tenth day of June A.D. 1850 and he adjudged the said will to be a valid will of real and personal estate and the proofs thereof to be sufficient which said last will and testament and proofs are as follows, to wit to say:

In the name of God Amen!
 I Delana M Barnes of the town of Albion County of Oswego, and State of New York, being of sound mind and memory, do make public and declare this my last will & testament, in manner following that is to say:

First, I give and devise to my husband Willard Barnes the sum of twelve hundred & thirty dollars, in trust for my child or children born subsequent to the execution of this my last will and testament

that in appropriate testimony of my husband and daughter Josephine said sum to be paid according to their several annual payments as mentioned in my mortgage against my Brother Lawson Barnes

Second I give and bequeath the note I hold against David H. Barnes of three hundred and twenty four dollars & 28 cents to benevolent purposes - One hundred Dollars to the Bible Society Fifty Dollars to Methodist Book Concern in State of New York Fifty Dollars to the Synagogue & worn out Preachers of the Methodist Episcopal Church for their support and benefit in the State of New York - Fifty dollars to Methodist Episcopal Church in Bellville - To be appropriated strictly for the advancement of the cause of Christ, and the promotion of the Church's interests twenty four dollars to the Missionary Society of the Black River Conference - The remainder of said sum shall be applied or used for the education of such persons for the Ministry of the Methodist Episcopal Church as have not means of their own or are otherwise unprovided for, in this qualifying them selves with useful knowledge that they may more successfully and zealously win souls to our common Lord & Savior said appropriations to be used for the benefit of the above named Conference and said institutions of New York.

Third, I give and bequeath my matter the sum of one hundred dollars to my sister Frances A. Barnes five hundred dollars to my sister Fernalis Chamberlain Mary Barnes and Amanda Armstrong all my right title and interest in and to my portion of my mother's former estate settled upon her to be divided equally between those three who are living when said portion shall be divided Lastly I give and bequeath the remainder of my estate if any beack of my living Brothers

and I do hereby make and appoint Edward B. Haves and Samuel Northrup of Ellisburgh Jefferson County my executors of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me made.

The above instrument was at the date hereof declared to be by Delana M Barnes the Testator therein mentioned she her last will & testament and she at the same time acknowledged to us and each of us that she had signed and sealed the same and we thereupon at her request were in her presence and in the presence of each other signed our names thereunto as witnesses
