Be it remembered that herebefore to-wit, on the 31 day of May A.D. 1850 Leroy Moore sole executor named in the last will and testament of Sidney Moore late of Orange County deceased appeared in open court before O. H. Whitney county Judge of Orange County and made application to have the said will, which relate to real and personal estate proved, and on such application the said judge did ascertain satisfactory who were the heirs and next of kin of the testator, and they being minors, a special guardian was appointed to care for their interests in this matter by an order entered for that purpose by said judge, and said judge did issue a citation to said guardian by name & state his name & that of the said minor requiring him to appear before said judge at the Fulton Hall in Fulton on the 13 day of June then next & there to prove the probate of said will, and on said 13 day of June 1850 evidence by affidavit was made of the service of the said citation as presented by said guardian, and as no one appeared to oppose such probate of said will such proceedings were then had that the said judge took the proof of the will hereafter set forth upon this 13 day of June A.D. 1850 and adjudged the said will to be a valid will of real & personal estate & the proof thereof to be sufficient which will & proofs are as follows:

In the name of God, Amen.

I Sidney Moore of the town of Colony village of Fulton County of Orange State of New York of the age of thirty eight years and being of sound mind and memory do make publish and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say,

I order and direct that my executor hereinafter named pay all my just debts and funeral expenses, and I give and bequeath the residue of my estate

to my beloved daughters Sarah Almira Moore & Liza Adell Moore to be equally divided between them. I also give and bequeath all of my real estate consisting of two villages lot situate in the village of Fulton with buildings on them to the said Sarah Almira Moore & Liza Adell Moore and I hereby order and direct my executor to see or to pay said real estate, if in his judgment it shall be necessary to raise money to pay the expenses as on said lot or for the maintenance & education of my two daughters above named and that the real estate or the avails of it be equally divided between the two daughters.

Third. It is my desire and request, that my brother Leroy Moore act as guardian for my two daughters until they become of suitable age, to act for themselves.

Fourth. I do hereby nominate and appoint my brother Leroy Moore sole executor of this my last will and testament, and I hereby expressly revoke all and every former will by me made.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty
