

Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the 22^d day of September A.D. 1858 Asa Curwens sole executor named in the last will & testament of Samuel Dunlop late of the town of Richland in the County of Oswego deceased appeared in open Court before the Seneca of Oswego County at his office in the City of Oswego & made application to have the said last will & testament proved which relates to both real & personal estate proved & on such application the the Seneca did adjourn by satisfactory by satisfactory evidence who were the widow heirs at law & next of kin of the said testator & their respective residences & the Seneca did thereupon issue a citation in due form of law directed to the said widow heirs & next of kin by their respective names stating their respective residences requiring them to appear before said Seneca at the Submision River house in the village of Pulaski in said County of Oswego on the 15th day of September 1858 to attend the probate of said will and afterwards to wit on the day & at the place before named satisfactory evidence by affidavit was produced to said Seneca of the due service of said citation in the mode prescribed by law & such proceedings were thereupon had that the Seneca then took the proofs of said will & he adjudged the said will to be a valid will of real & personal property & the proofs thereof to be sufficient which said last will & testament & the proofs thereof are as follows to wit to say

I Samuel Dunlop of the town of Richland County of Oswego in the State of New York aged sixty eight years and upwards and being of sound mind and memory do make public and declare this my last will and testament in manner following to wit to say

I give and bequeath to my wife Lydia the use and occupation of all my estate both real & personal of whatever nature or nature and to be used for her support and maintenance during the whole time of her natural life after paying all the debts dues and demands which I may owe or which may be against my estate at the time of my decease including funeral expenses and I further direct that all the lands which I now lying east of the ridge road leading from Sandy Creek to Jonathan Bergsands house be sold by my executor and the avails thereof made use of in the payment of my debts and if my personal property shall be insufficient to pay the same and the balance
