

The Last Will and Testament of Clarissa Gray
of the town of Orange, County of Orange, State
of New York -

I Clarissa Gray, considering the uncertainty
of this mortal life and being of sound mind
and memory, blessed be Almighty God for the same,
do make and publish this my last will and testament
in manner and form following, that is to say,
first I give and devise unto my son Henry
Gray all of the real estate which I now own and
possess being the farms on which I now reside
in said town of Orange to hold to contain
sixty two acres to three parts of four

Secondly, I will and bequeath to my son Charles
Gray two hundred dollars \$200.00, the said
two hundred dollars to be paid to the said Charles
by Henry Gray within one year after my decease.
Thirdly I will and bequeath to my two daughters
Clarissa now the wife of Edmund P. Jones and
Abigail now the wife of Lewis P. Appleton
each one equal half in value all the household
furniture and wearing apparel that may
belong to me at my decease. All which
household furniture and wearing apparel to be
delivered to them in manner above specified
immediately after my decease. And lastly I
do hereby appoint Henry Gray sole executor
of this my last will and testament.
