curtains with white coverlet two pair of sheets

and blanket sufficient for winter & summer, and
also fine silver teaspoons and my china cups &
saucers, also my ruff and tippet.

Third I give and bequeath to William Edward
& Allen son of the said Pardee & Allen twenty
five dollars in cash.

Fourth All the residue of my estate real and
personal of every description I give and bequeath
to the said Pardee & Allen to have
he share and assign forever.

Fifth I hereby nominate constitute & appoint
the said Pardee & Allen executor of this my
last will and testament.

in the year one thousand eight hundred and
fifty three.
