of Ellensburg in the County of Jefferson and  
State of New York. I Isaac Mester, consider-  
ing the uncertainty of mortal life, and  
a life being felt in body, but of a sound  
mind and memory, blessed be strong by  
God for the same. Do make and publish  
this my last will and testament in manner and  
form following (what is to say) after my death  
and funeral charges are paid. First I give and  
bequeath to Nancy & Borua Five Hundred Dollars  
in and out of my personal property, shall amount to  
the said sum of Five Hundred Dollars, in case  
my real estate shall amount to said sum of  
Five Hundred Dollars after my decease. Then  
I give and bequeath the said sum of Five Hundred  
Dollars as aforesaid. But in case my real and  
personal property does not amount to said sum  
of five hundred dollars at the time of my decease  
then I give to said Nancy & Borua in lieu of  
the said five hundred Dollars all my real and  
personal property of whatever name or nature.  
And lastly, I hereby appoint my beloved Wife  
Marion the sole executrix of this my last will  
and testament. hereby revoking all former  
wills by me made and declaring this to be my  
last will and testament. in witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the  
fourth day of February, in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and fifty three (1853)
