

I Joshua Mack of the Town of New Haven County of Orange and State of New York, of the age of twenty seven years, and being of sound mind and memory, do make publick and declare this my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say

First I give and bequeath to my wife Lucy all household furniture beds bedding and all other property she brought into my family when she came to live with me, some two years since, also all additions she may have made or purchased to the same, since she has lived with me, of whatever kind or description it may be.

I also give and bequeath to her my said wife Lucy all her wearing Apparel of every kind, one red six year old Hind back cow - five sheep and one hundred dollars in money to be paid her out of money loaned by me to certain persons if not paid to me during my life, if that be done, then to be paid her out of the avails of any other property belonging to my estate, having estimated the value of my real estate at \$3380 or so it being, at the rate of forty five dollars per acre. I further give and bequeath to my said wife Lucy the legal interest of one thousand one hundred and ten dollars being one third of my appraised value of said real estate, which I direct to be so loaned or deposited as will produce the legal interest and paid to her semi-annually if such arrangement can be made, if not at least annually for and during her natural life, the foregoing bequests are made to my wife Lucy in lieu of dower.

I also give and bequeath to my several daughters to wit Nancy now the wife of Alexander May the sum of one hundred dollars - Abby now the wife of David A. Branch the sum of one hundred dollars Charlotte now the wife of Rufus Parkhurst the sum of one hundred dollars - Susanna now the

wife of Eli Parsons the sum of one hundred dollars and to Elizabeth now the wife of George Bunniff the sum of one hundred dollars, which several bequests are to be paid to them or their legal representatives as soon as may be convenient after my decease and to be paid by my executors out of the avails of property when sold, and all the residue and remainder of the avails of my said property Real and personal I give and bequeath and to my several sons to wit

Samuel Mack, Norman Mack, William A. Mack, Milo A. Mack, and John W. Mack to them and to their heirs share and share alike excepting however from the share of my youngest son John W. Mack the sum of fifty dollars he had already received from me, then unto all to share equally - And I hereby further do and fully empower my executors herein after mentioned by me appointed to sell and dispose of all my property either at publick or private sale, both real and personal as shall seem best to them for the interest of my said estate - And I do hereby fully empower him to make execute and deliver as executor of this my last will and testament good and sufficient deed or deeds of conveyance to the purchase or purchases of my said real estate and after paying all just and legal claims that may be existing against me at the time of my death and funeral expenses and after paying the legacies above mentioned to my said wife and Daughters and the said sum of \$1110 loaned or deposited so that the interest of the same shall go to the benefit of my said wife as aforesaid then the balance of the said avails to be paid over to my said sons as aforesaid and after the decease of her
