William Halsey

DECEASED

Be it Remembered, That, heretofore, to wit: on the 8th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one

Execut. named in the Last Will and Testament of William Halsey late of the Town of Mexico in the County of Oswego and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament which relates to both Real and Personal Estate proved: and on such application the said Surrogate did ascertain, by satisfactory evidence, who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences.

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation, in due form of law, directed to the heirs at law and next of kin by their respective names, stating their respective places of residence, them to appear before said Surrogate at his office in the Village of Mexico in said County, on the 16th day of September A. D. 1851 to attend the Probate of said Will.

And whereas, to wit: on the 7th day of October A. D. 1851, satisfactory evidence by affidavit was produced and presented to said Surrogate, of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day, no one appearing to oppose the Probate of said Will, proceedings were thereupon had in said Court afterwards, that the said Surrogate took the oath of said Will and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the oath thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament, and oath, are as follows, to wit:
