

Last Will and Testament of

Charles Adams

DECEASED

Be it Remembered, That, herebefore, to wit: on the 21st day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one

of the County of Oswego, late of the Town of Hamlet in the County of Oswego deceased, appeared in open Court before the Surrogate of the County of Oswego and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament which relates to both Real and Personal Estate proved: and on such application the said Surrogate did ascertain by satisfactory evidence, who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences:

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation in due form of law directed to the heirs at law and next of kin by their respective names, stating their respective residences, requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at the County of Oswego on the 23rd day of October 1861 to attend the Probate of said Will.

And all parties interested appearing consented in writing to the immediate probate of said Will.

And afterwards, to wit: on the 23rd day of September A. D. 1861, satisfactory evidence by affidavit was produced and presented to said Surrogate of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day, no one appearing to oppose the Probate of such Will such proceedings were thereupon had in said Court; afterwards, that the said Surrogate took the oath of said Will hereafter set forth, upon this 23rd day of September A. D. 1861, and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate; and the proof thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament, and proof, are as follows, that is to say:

WILL

In the name of God Amen, I Oscar D. Barrus of the town of Hamlet in the County of Oswego and State of New York being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of life do therefore make and publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament: That is to say: First, I will that all my lawful and just debts be paid satisfied and discharged. Deceased: I will and bequeath unto my wife Mary P. Barrus the sum of \$1000.00
