Be it Remembered, That hereof to wit on the 21 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty one of our Minnery
Executors named in the Last Will and Testament of Henry Minnery late of the Town of Mexico in the County of Oswego and State of New York, deceased, appeared in open Court before the Surrogate of the County of Oswego and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament which relates to both Real and Personal Estate approved and on such application the said Surrogate did ascertain by satisfactory evidence who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation in due form of law directed to the heirs at law and next of kin by their respective names stating their respective places of residence and requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at the office of the Surrogate in the Village of Chateaufort in said County on the 9th day of Decr A. D. 1861 to attend the Probate of said Will

And afterwards to wit on the 9th day of Decr A. D. 1861 satisfactory evidence by affidavit was produced and presented to said Surrogate of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day no one appearing to oppose the Probate of said Will such proceedings were thereupon had in said County afterwards that the said Surrogate took the oath of said Will hereinafter set forth upon this 9th day of Decr A. D. 1861 and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the oaths thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament and oaths are as follows, that is to say:
