Second: I give and bequeath unto the American Bible Society Fifty Dollars to be paid to said Society by my Executors in one year after my decease.

Third: I give and bequeath unto the American Board of Foreign Missions Fifty Dollars to be paid to said Society by my Executors in one year after my decease.

Fourth: I give and bequeath unto Mary Ann Perry the wife of James Howland of the Town of Allegan County of Allegan State of Michigan Our Picture in frame and one large Looking Glass now in my possession.

Fifthly: I give and bequeath unto Jullmacege Perry Fifty Dollars to be paid to him by my Executors in one year after my decease. Also whatever Household Furniture Clothing of every description which I shall own or be possessed of at the time of my death.

Sixthly: I give and bequeath unto the children of Jullmacege Perry Fifty Dollars to be paid to him in One Year after my decease and the residue to be invested by my Executors and placed at interest to be repaid to them whenever they may direct by giving thirty days notice.

I further direct my Executors to pay to him such sum or sums as they shall deem proper taking into consideration his education.

I further instruct and advise my Executors if they think proper they may invest said money in Bonds, to be held by them (or some person lawfully appointed) for his benefit.

Seventhly: I do hereby nominate and appoint Jullmacege Perry of the Town of Oswego and Benjamin Howland Jr of the City of Oswego Executors of this my last Will and Testament and hereby expressly revoke all and every former Will and Testament by me made.
