

of sixty two (62) acres of land, and being part of Lot No. Thirty two (32) in the Town of Grassy Runny of Oswego and State of New York with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to have and to hold the same to himself and to his heirs forever, subject however to the conditions and provisions hereinafter made for him to keep and perform.

Second. I give and bequeath to my two daughters, viz. Nancy Annancia Higgins and Sophia Amelia Hunt each One Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$130.) to be paid to each of them \$130. by my said son Overt Barnes, in two years after my decease in case my said daughter be living at that time, or either of them, and only to such as may then.

Third. I give and bequeath to my youngest daughter Ann Eliza Barnes Two Hundred and fifty Dollars (\$250) to be paid to her by my said son Overt Barnes within two years after my decease.
