

against me. I also give her the sole use and control of my real estate situate in the town of Orange which I now reside in so long as she shall remain my widow and no longer.

3rd I hereby direct that my daughter Joanna shall have her support and maintenance out of the proceeds of my farm so long as she shall remain unmarried even after the death of my wife and in case she should not remain with the other heirs on my farm after the decease of myself and wife by reason of any disagreement between them then she is to have a reasonable sum each year for her support she using all the industry and economy that may be useful to assist in so doing. I also bequeath her Five Dollars at the decease of my wife.

4th I give and bequeath to my son Patrick Five Dollars to be paid here on the death of my wife and should his needs be great advise my heirs to supply them from time to time.

4th I give and devise to my sons John and Timothy all my real estate for the description of which reference is made to a deed executed October 10th 1839 and recorded in Orange Co: Clerk's Office November 13th 1839 at Five o'clock PM in Book 30 of said pages 200, 211 also to a deed executed January 13th 1842 and recorded in Orange Co: Clerk's Office March 31st 1846 at 3 o'clock PM in Book 43 of said pages 504, 505 to have and to hold the same their heirs and assigns forever subject to the payment of the several sums bequeathed in this instrument also to the support of my daughter Joanna as before specified my said sons to have equal undivided shares of said real estate and to come into possession of the same on the decease or marriage of my wife Annora.

5th I give and bequeath to my daughter Ellen Mary the sum of Five Dollars to be paid her on the death of my wife Annora.

6th I hereby nominate and appoint my Brother in Law Timothy Mahony my sole Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixteenth day of January in the year One thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty two.
