

Last Will and Testament of

Richard Bradford

DECEASED

It is Remembered, That heretofore, to wit: on the 5th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 1862

Richard Bradford late of the Town of West Monroe in the County of Oswego and State of New York deceased, appeared in open Court, before the Surrogate of the County of Oswego and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament, which relates to both Real and Personal Estate, approved: and in such application the said Surrogate did ascertain, by satisfactory evidence, who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences.

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation, in due form of law, directed to the heirs at law and next of kin by their respective names, stating their respective places of residence, requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at 11 o'clock in the Village of West Monroe in said County, on the 23rd day of June A. D. 1862, to attend the Probate of said Will.

And afterwards, to wit: on the 23rd day of June A. D. 1862, satisfactory evidence by affidavit, was produced and presented to said Surrogate, of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day, no one appearing to oppose the Probate of such Will proceedings were thereupon had in said Court, upon which the said Surrogate took the oath of said Will hereinafter set forth, upon this 23rd day of June A. D. 1862, and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the proof thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament, and proof, are as follows, that is to say:
