

Last Will and Testament of

Richard Bradford

DECEASED.

Be it Remembered, That lastly, to wit: on the 28 day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 63 by Law

Richard Bradford named in the Last Will and Testament of Richard Bradford late of the Town of West Monroe in the County of Oswego and State of New York deceased, appeared in open Court, before the Surrogate of the County of Oswego and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament, which relates to both Real and Personal Estate, proved: and on such application the said Surrogate did ascertain, by satisfactory evidence, who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences.

And all parties interested having consented to the aforesaid proof of said Will

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation, in due form of law, directed to the heirs at law and next of kin by their respective names, stating their respective places of residence, requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at in the County of Oswego on the 28 day of July 1863, to attend the Probate of said Will.

And afterwards, to wit: on the 29 day of July A. D. 1863, satisfactory evidence by affidavit, was produced and presented to said Surrogate, of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day, no one appearing to oppose the Probate of such Will, such proceedings were thereupon had in said Court, afterwards, that the said Surrogate took the oath of said Will, hereinafter set forth, upon this 29 day of July A. D. 1863, and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the proof thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament, and proof, are as follows, that is to say:
