

Last Will and Testament of

Bartholomew Vanier

DECLARED

Be it Remembered, That, lastly, to wit: on the 20th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Two

Bartholomew Vanier

Bartholomew Vanier, late of the Town of Williamstown in the County of Orange and State of New York, deceased, appeared in open Court, before the Surrogate of the County of Orange, and made application to have the said Last Will and Testament, which relates to both Real and Personal Estate, proved: and on such application the said Surrogate did avouch, by satisfactory evidence, who were the heirs at law and next of kin of the said testator, and their respective residences,

and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a Citation, in due form of law, directed to the heirs at law and next of kin, by their respective names, stating their respective places of residences, requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at his office in the County of Orange, on the 26th day of July 1862, to attend the Probate of said Will.

And afterwards, on the 15th day of July 1862, satisfactory evidence by affidavits was produced and presented to said Surrogate, of the due service of said Citation in the mode prescribed by law, and on that day, no one appearing to oppose the Probate of said Will, proceedings were thereupon had in said Court, afterwards, that the said Surrogate, with the proof of said Will, hereinafter set forth, upon this 15th day of July 1862, and he thereupon adjudged the said Will to be a valid Will of Real and Personal Estate, and the proof thereof to be sufficient, which said Last Will and Testament, and proof, are as follows, that is to say:
