 property her life time and then to be equally divided amongst them
 provided she remains my widow and if not when my death shall become
 twenty one they shall have their portion.

I do nominate and appoint my beloved wife Martha and Horace
 King to be the sole executor of this my last Will and Testament
 In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal and published and
 declared this to be my last will and Testament in presence of the witnesses
 named below this 15th day of April 1859 in the year of our Lord One
 Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty nine.
