

The sum of five hundred Dollars to be paid to him on his arriving at the age of twenty one years and the further sum of five hundred Dollars on his arriving at the age of thirty years.

Second. I give and bequeath to my infant son James B. the sum of five hundred Dollars to be paid to him when he becomes twenty one years of age and also the further sum of five hundred Dollars when he arrives at the age of thirty years and I direct that my son James shall receive at the expense of my Estate a good education as near equal to that of my son John B. as can conveniently be.

Third. I give and bequeath and devise to my wife Ann Smith all the residue and remainder of my Estate real, personal and mixed after paying my debts during her life. To be accepted and received by her in lieu of dower and after her decease I give and bequeath and devise my said real and personal Estate to my two sons John B. and James B. their heirs and assigns forever to be divided equally between them share and share alike and I hereby appoint my said wife Ann sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament and I request my said executrix to advise in relation to the settling and the business of my said Estate with Wolsten Hager my bookkeeper and Isaac Finney of Mexico.

Fourth. I direct that my said executrix settle with my Brothers John and Peter Smith as early as February next and charge them a reasonable commission for the care and trouble for keeping the money safely for them which is to be deducted out of the amount she pays them.

I also direct that all moneys collected and not on account that is sufficient to defray the expenses of the family and the education of my son James B. and the debts above specified shall be invested in Bond and mortgage upon Real Estate not to exceed the sum want.

Fifthly. I further direct that if in case my said wife as executrix shall in due judgment think it advisable to pay the ~~above~~ mentioned sums of five hundred Dollars each to my sons ~~withholding~~ when they each arrive at the age of twenty one years she may do so and in that case the above legacies to be paid when they arrived at thirty years and not to be paid to either of them.

Sixthly. I hereby empower my said wife to sell and dispose of any or all my personal and Real Estate at public or private sale at such time or times and upon such terms and in such manner as to her shall seem meet and I hereby receive all former Wills by me made.
