In matter of Henry Rust administrator of Noah Rust deceased. Ordered that the further hearing on the matter of the said Henry's petition for the sale of so much of the real estate of which the said Noah died seized as will be sufficient to pay his debts be adjourned to the sixth day of May next at the same place at eight o'clock in the forenoon (The last above order was endorsed as follows) C. May 6 - Ordered that the further hearing on the matter within contained be adjourned to the 13th May instant at eight o'clock A.M.

Oswego County -

At a Surrogate's Court held at Richland in said county on the ninth day of April 1823 before Whester Simpson Surrogate of said county pursuant to and order of the said surrogate made on the 17th day of March last stating that Henry Rust Administrator of Noah Rust late of Oswego in the county of Oswego deceased had presented to the said surrogate an account of the personal estate and of the debts of the said Noah deceased as far forth as she had been able to ascertain the same and filed said account in the office of the said surrogate from which it appeared that the said personal estate was insufficient for the payment of the said debts and ordering therefore that all persons interested in the estate

of the said Noah Rust deceased should appear before the said surrogate at his office in Richland aforesaid on the twenty ninth day of April then next at nine o'clock in the forenoon to show cause if they had why so much of the real estate of which the said Noah died seized should not be sold as would be sufficient to pay his debts. And ordering further that notice of the said order should be published four weeks successively in the newspaper called the Observer published in the county of Oswego and in the Oswego Palladium published in the county of Oswego there being no other paper printed in the said county of Oswego - and notice being made of the publication of notice of said order pursuant to the terms thereof - Heran Holbhill having been appointed by the said surrogate Guardian of Richard Rust an infant son and heir of the said Noah Rust deceased for the sole purpose of appearing for and taking care of the interests of the said infant on the proceedings to be had in the premises appears in behalf of the said infant - and Noah Rust appears in behalf of the Administrator whereupon after hearing the testimony of the said Noah Rust in the premises it is ordered by the said surrogate that the further hearing of the said premises and all matters in relation thereto be adjourned to the sixth day of May next at eight o'clock in the forenoon at the office of the said surrogate in Richland aforesaid.

At which day at the place aforesaid appears the said administrator by Robert P. Richardson as her attorney and the said Richard Rust by his said Guardian and after hearing the proofs and allegations of the parties now here produced it is ordered that the further hearing of the premises be adjourned to the thirteenth day of May instant at eight o'clock in the forenoon of that day at the office of the said surrogate at Richland aforesaid.
