In matter of the real estate of Simon Adams deceased } Whereas a petition was heretofore presented in the twenty eighth day of May last past presented to this Court by Simon Adams Executor of the last will and testament of Simon Adams deceased setting forth that the said Simon Adams deceased setting forth that the said deceased was at the time of his death seized of certain real estate in this State that the petitioner has made a just and true account of the personal estate of the said deceased and of his debts and thereby had discovered and had reason to suspect that the personal estate of the said deceased was insufficient to pay his debts and thereupon requesting the aid of this Court in the premises. And whereas upon presenting the said petition the said Executor did file in the office of the said surrogate an account of the personal estate and of the debts of the said deceased which he alleged under oath to be just and true according to the best of his
