

At a Surrogate Court held for the County of Orange at the Town of Rockland in said County, the twenty eighth day of June A.D. 1839. Present. Joseph W. Kibbe, Surrogate
In the matter of the real estate of Thomas Kibbe deceased

On reading and filing the report of sale in the matter setting forth the proceedings had under the decree of sale made in this matter on the twenty eighth day of March last past and the affidavits thereto annexed by all which it appears that the administrators of the estate of the said deceased did on the tenth day of June instant (after giving due and legal notice thereof, and conforming in all respects to the requirements of the statute in such case made and provided) sell at public auction the following lots pieces or parcels of land situate and being in the Village of Patton and Town of Tolney in said County being part of the same location (as called) and designated on a map of the Village of Patton as follows that is to say - in Block number eleven lots numbers two, three & four. in Block number eight lots from number one to number nine inclusive. - in Block number nine lots from number one to number five inclusive - in Block number thirteen lots from number one to number five inclusive - in Block number fourteen lots from number one to number twenty four inclusive - in Block number twenty two lots numbers one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight & ten - in Block number nineteen lot number four - in Block number twenty North end of lot number one which includes all of the said lot number one not previously sold. - in Block number twenty three lots one seven & ten, as the same are described in said decree of sale and being part of the premises ordered by the said decree to be sold as aforesaid, and being also part of the real estate of the said deceased; and that the said premises were struck off and sold as follows. all the lots mentioned above as sold in Block numbers seven, eight, nine, thirteen, fourteen and twenty two, were struck off to Theophilus S. Morgan of the Village of Orange for the sum of three thousand dollars he being the highest bidder for the same - That

lot number four in Block number nineteen, and the part of lot number one in Block number twenty were struck off to Isaac Schuch of County in said County he being the highest bidder for the same for the sum of two hundred and fifty five dollars - that lot number one in Block number twenty three was struck off to Isaac Schuch of Cazenovia in the County of Madison for fifty one dollars he being the highest bidder for the same - that lot number seven in Block number twenty three was struck off to Isaac Schuch of Tolney aforesaid for ninety dollars he being the highest bidder for the same - that lot number ten in Block number twenty three was struck off to Henry Kavelius of Tolney aforesaid for the sum of forty one dollars he being the highest bidder for the same - upon the terms set forth in the said Report. And it further appearing from an examination of the said proceedings, that the said sale has been legally made, and all the proceedings fairly conducted. It is ordered that the sale be to the same is hereby confirmed, and it is further ordered that a conveyance for the said premises be made in due form of law by the administrators of the said deceased to the said purchasers respectively upon their complying with the terms of sale on their part respectively to be performed.
