It is therefore ordered and the Surrogate doth certify
out to the statute aforesaid doth order that the said claim
whereas as aforesaid, with the following described, viz. to wit,
whereof the said intestate did seized to enable him to pay
said debts aforesaid of the intestate that is to say:

Parcel No. 1. All that tract or parcel of land situated in
the town of Amherst County of Orange and State of Va.
and described as follows: Being a parcel of land taken
off the south east corner of Lot No. 2 and beginning at a
point where the center line of said lot strikes the center of the
highway and running thence along the center of the same
ten rods and one half rods to a stake; thence north westerly
and one half rods to a stake standing three rods from the
