PRETTY LAMP-SHADES.

How to Make Artistic Lamp-Shades Composed Entirely of Roses. Artistic lamp-shades made entirely of roses, with deep lace flouncing drooping about the edges, are not an impossibility to a person having a small parlor. One can be easily made by any woman who has neat and capable fingers. The first requirement is to purchase a wire lamp-shade to fit the lamp for which the shade is intended. Yellow and pink are the two favorite colors for the roses, the first imitating *M. rosal* and the pink *M. rosal* or *B. rosal*. The pink roses give the soft light and require more tissue paper than the yellow.

HOME AND FARM.

About 100 different kinds of leeches are now known to attack corn.
