James Elwin Sibbitts, 58, long a farmer at Martins Corners, was fatally injured about 7 p. m. Sunday night when he was kicked in the face and head by a colt he was training.

The accident happened in a field near his house while he was train-

ing the animal, a hobby of his. He was knocked unconscious and was still in a coma when he died in the Potsdam hospital, an hour later.

Death was caused by a fractured skull, shock and other injuries.

He is survived by his second wife, Mrs. Grace Loucks Sibbitts, a daughter by his first marriage, Mrs. Joseph (Jennie) Wells, Poughkeepsie; a step-daughter,

Mrs. LaVerne Huth, Star Lake; a daughter, Mrs. Geprge -Lois Miller, at home, and two sons, Richard and Ronald Sibbitts. Four grandchildren also survive.

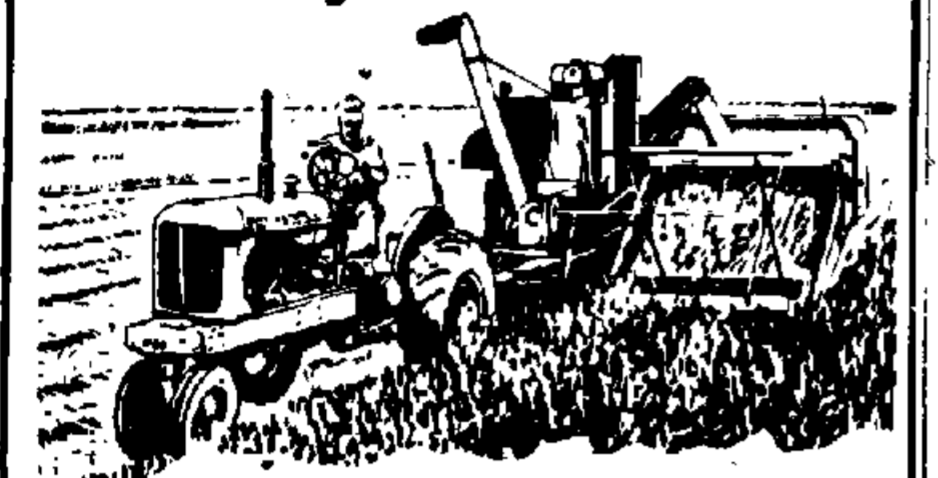
