The State Department, meanwhile, supplied some ammunition for supporters of the measure with a 46-page printed document replying to 111 questions submitted by members of Congress.

Throughout its carefully worded answers, the department insisted that while the aid program is directed at saving Greece from falling into the hands of Communist-directed guerrillas and Turkey from succumbing to pressure from without there is no threat to any "legitimate interests of the Soviet Union."

"In the opinion of the Department of State, the Soviet Union would not be entitled to interpret the proposed assistance as an unfriendly and overt act on our part, justifying retaliatory measures on the part of the Soviet Union," said one of the answers.

The greatest threat to Greece's stability, the State Department document said, lies in the attempts of 15,000 guerrillas to overthrow the present government. Noting that most of these warriors are not Communists, the department said:

"However, virtually all of their leaders are Communists and instruction in Communist political doctrine is regularly given to all units of the hands. Each unit, down to that of the company, has a political commissar attached to it."

The department strongly defended the right of Turkey to assistance, asserting that the Turks had practiced "benevolent neutrality" toward the Allies during the war.

The State Department said: "In many ways Turkey actively assisted the Allies by admitting Allied technicians to Turkish territory, allowing the establishment of Allied supply dumps, and facilitating the passage of Allied wounded escaped prisoners and so forth through Turkey, all of which was in technical violation of the requirements of neutrality."

It denied flatly that American oil concessions in the Middle East are linked with the Greece-Turkey aid program, an issue that had been raised by Senator Brewster (R-Me.).

To those who wondered whether the aid program would bypass the United Nations, the department said in response to several questions that it would keep the U. N. fully informed of developments.

The U. N. would be given, under the amendment approved by the Foreign Relations Committee, the right to call a halt to American aid when it was prepared to take over such an assistance program itself.
