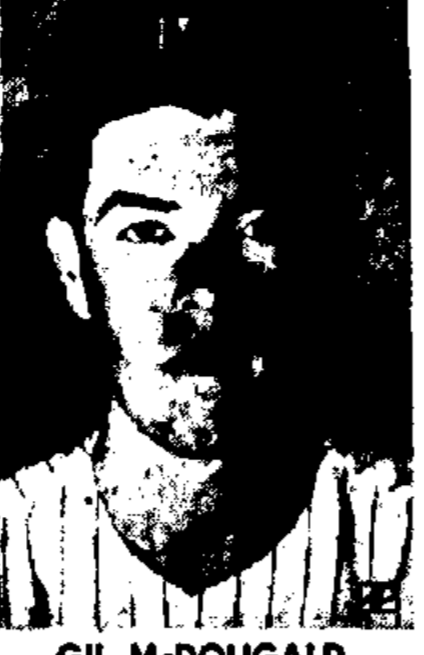
All Banks Open Until 5 Thursday
