### JUDGE CAN'T SEE JOKE IN HERDING GEESE BY PLANE

The tenderfoot who was sent out to round up the lambs on a western sheep ranch, and at nightfall closed the corral on 50 panting jackrabbits, met his match recently in two native Oklahomans who set out in an airplane to ride herd on a flock of wild geese.

They succeeded, but too well. Circling about the river banks they forced together an enormous flock, and drove the birds southward along the river. Here "hunters" were waiting in blinds and fired almost point-blank into the mass of birds.

The fun was taken out of this new form of slaughter, however, when the "herd riders" in the airplane

learned that game wardens had witnessed the incident. Oklahoma, like many other states with progressive fish and game commissions, prohibits the hunting of birds from airplanes, and the two airplane pilots paid fines of \$131 each.

London Rape French Plays  
Following the presentation of *Cheri*, an adaptation of a pre-war Parisian novel by Colette, London theatergoers are protesting against the production of certain French plays. The objections are strongest against sordid works which are supposed to show "life as it is," but really are only unpleasant perversions that evoke repulsion in the English mind. Plays or books which do not lend themselves to translation are also scored. One London dramatic critic declares that dialogues such as "You are an ass," with the answer, "That's my profession," as given in *Cheri*, may be wit, but it is not worth going to a theater to hear. *Cheri* tells of the mutual attraction of a youth and a woman old enough to be his mother, with a worded background of old women who cackle of their triumphs in the past.

### Onondaga County Builds 158 Miles Of Concrete Roads
